# Curriculum Provision – Year 7

- Sept to Oct pupils will be taught in these Mixed Ability tutor groups.
- November onwards pupils will be allocated a “school band” and reorganised into “streams”

- Allocation of “school band” – minimum expected outcome at Key Stage 3 and 4.



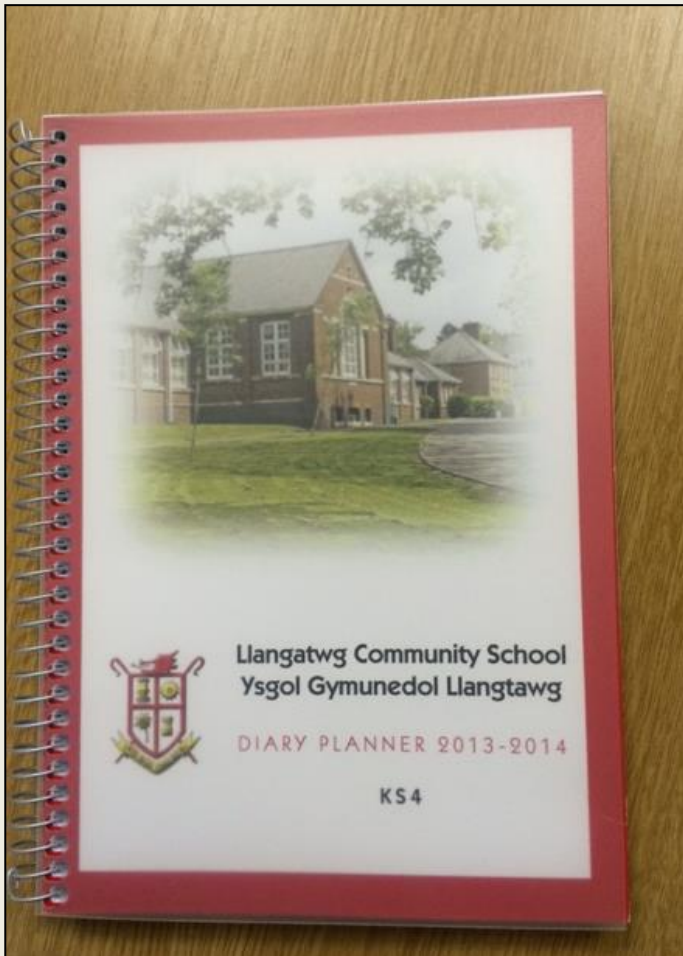
